

Subsequently, Joseph M. Austin, Jr., died intestate and his interest in said property became vested in his father, Joseph M. Austin, and his brothers, J. Alfred Austin and James F. Austin, his sole heirs-at-law. Thereafter, the said Joseph M. Austin, J. Alfred Austin and James F. Austin conveyed all their interest in said property to William H. Austin, Hattie Austin Woody and Gertrude Austin Knox by their deed dated July 10, 1939, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Deed Book 212, at Page 176. Thereafter, Gertrude Austin Knox died, leaving her will, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County in Apartment 533, File 28, under which she devised all her interest in this property to her children, Wyckliffe A. Knox, Peter S. Knox, Jr., Wm. Lawrence Manning Knox and Robert Edward Knox. Thereafter, William H. Austin died intestate January 2, 1948, leaving Gabrielle Austin and Charley V. Austin, his children, as his sole heirs and distributees as will more fully appear by reference to Apartment 543, File 4, in the Office of the Probate Court for Greenville County, S.C.
