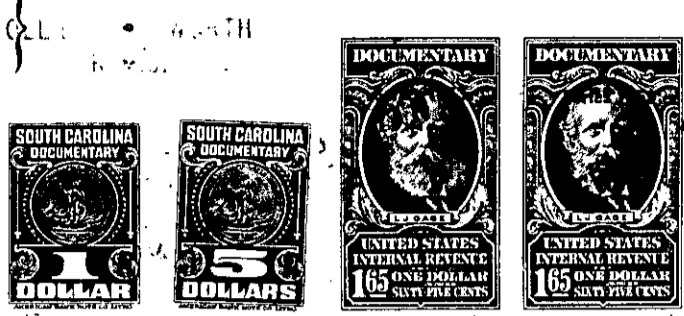

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That we, - Jesse Pruitt, Gladys Farmer,
 Joseph Henry Brannon, Carlisle Brannon, Ernestine Simmons,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of twenty-nine hundred and no/100
(\$2900.00) dollars, Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
 by William R. Brannon, David W. Brannon and Lillie B. Brannon,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
 these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said William R. Brannon, David
W. Brannon and Lillie B. Brannon, their respective heirs and assigns
 forever:- all of our respective right, title, interest and estate, present
 and future, at law or in equity, of, in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, on the Pelham Road, and being a part of the same
 conveyed to J. O. Stokes by T. J. Glasgow by deed dated December 5th,
 1922, and recorded in Vol. 87 page 8, R.M.C. office this County, and
 having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Beginning at iron pin on the east side of the said Pelham Road; thence
 N 83 W two hundred fifty (250) feet to branch; thence up the meander-
 ings of said branch due North eighty-six (86) feet to a stake; thence
 S 83 E one hundred ninety-nine and five-tenths (199.5) feet to the
 Pelham Road; thence along this road, N 1 E ninety-six and one-tenth
 (96.1) feet to the beginning part.

Also that certain other lot or parcel of land in said County and State,
 Chick Springs Township, near the City of Greer, and on the east side of
 the New Pelham Road, and having the following courses and distances,
 to-wit:-

Beginning at the corner of No. four (4) lot, and runs thence with the
 line of #4 lot, East two hundred (200) feet to point; thence South
 sixty-three and seven-tenths (63.7) feet to J. O. Stokes corner; thence
 with his line West two hundred (200) feet to the new Pelham Road;
 thence with said road, North sixty-two and two-tenths (62.2) feet to the
 beginning point and being all of No. five (5) lot as shown on plat of
 the Odam lots.

The above properties are part of the estate of K. D. Brannon, owned by
 him at the time of his death.
