do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Eugene E. Stone, III, Thomas W. Miller, Eugene E. Stone, Jr., Ward S. Stone and Eugene E. Stone, Trustees under the Last Will and Testament of Theodore C. Stone, Deceased, subject to the provisions therein stated:

All the right, title and interest of the Grantors herein acquired by and through the deed of Ruth W. Stone, dated August 21, 1958, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 605 at page 48, in and to:

All real estate wheresoever situate owned by T.C. Stone, Deceased, at the time of his death, excepting only therefrom that lot with all improvements thereon at the intersection of Fall and East Broad Streets in the City of Greenville, Lot No. 55, Section 2 of Stone Lake Heights and lot with the residence thereon at Cedar Mountain, Transylvania County, North Carolina.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Eugene E. Stone, III, Thomas W. Miller, Eugene E. Stone, Jr., Ward S. Stone and Eugene E. Stone, Trustees under the Last Will and Testament of Theodore C. Stone, Deceased, their successors, ~~xxx~~ and Assigns forever.
