(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harold George
his heirs and assigns, forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land
situate and being Grove Township, State and County aforesaid, containing Two
acres, more or less, and being on West side of public road formerly known as
Grove Road.

Adjoining lands of myself, Clarence George and possibly others.

Having the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at a
point in public road leading from Rehoboth Church to Highway 20 S. 78:15 E.
175 feet to a point in said road; thence S. 13 W. 49 feet to an iron pin;
thence S. 44 W. 350 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79:15 W. to an iron pin; 27 ft.
thence S. 77 W. 115 feet to an angle; thence N. 88 W. 114.2 feet; thence N. 42 E.
400.8 feet to beginning corner.
