to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said DAVID F. LAWLESS AND DORIS VIRGINIA LAWLESS, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Grove Township, on the eastern side of South Carolina Highway 29, being shown and designated as Lot 6 on plat of the property of Troy C. Davis and Frances G. Davis, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the eastern side of S. C. Highway 29 at the joint front corner of Lots 6 and 7 and running thence with the line of Lot 7 N. 87-30 E. 545 feet more or less to the Southern Railway; thence along the Southern Railway S. 4-35 W. 85 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot 5; thence with the line of Lot 5 S. 85-35 W. 545 feet more or less to pin on easternside of Highway 29; thence with the eastern side of said highway N. 4-30 E. 85 feet to the point of beginning.
