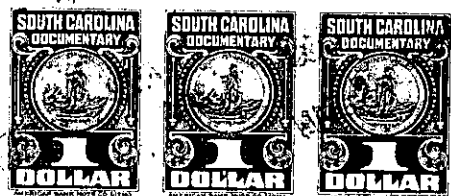
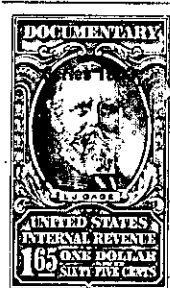
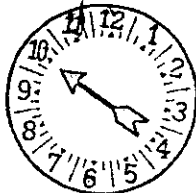

these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Addie Beatrice Kelly,
her heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, on the west side of U. S. Highway #29, and known and

designated as Lots Nos. 26 and 27 of the T. D. Bennett sub-division as shown by
plat made by G. Sam Lowe, Registered C. E., dated August 24, 1948, and
recorded in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office in Plat Book S, page 143,
and according to said plat more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the south side of Bennett Street at the rear corner of
