

NOW, Therefore, Know all men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman, Master in and for the County of Greenville, aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty Five Hundred and no/100----- (\$2500.00)----- Dollars,

to me paid by the said A. L. Cannon

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said A. L. Cannon

ALL of that parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the north side of Few's Bridge Road, about three miles northwest of Oneal, bounded on the north and east by lands of A. L. Cannon, on the south by lands of B. M. Cannon and said road, and on the west by A. C. Rollins, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on an iron pin in the Few's Bridge Road, corner with lot formerly owned by Walter Rollins, now A. C. Rollins, and runs thence with the line of that lot, N. 34-15 W. 224 feet to an iron pin on that line; thence N. 74-45 E. 208.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 34-15 E. 224 feet to an iron pin on the Few's Bridge Road (iron pin back on line at 18.5 feet); thence along and with said road, S. 77-45 W. 208.6 feet to the beginning corner, containing one acre, more or less.
