I, E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Carey R. Harris, W. R. Harris, Emmie Patricia H. Toney, E. Caroline Harris Head and Dorothy H. Stroud

on or about the 4th day of June in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and fifty-eight exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Elizabeth H. Hair, individually and as Surviving Executrix and Trustee of the Estate of John D. Harris, deceased, and as Executrix of the Estate of Mary Elizabeth Harris, deceased; The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston, as Administrator de bonis non of the Estate of Nell H. Hewell, deceased; and Hylan Elizabeth Hewell and John Witherspoon Hewell, III,

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 2nd day of March 1961,

and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to W. R. Harris

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said W. R. Harris

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in _____ Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, and being known and designated as Tract No. 1-A on a plat of property of J. D. Harris Estate made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, January, 1953, revised November 13, 1960, and recorded in the office of the R.M.C. for Greenville County in Plat Book MM, Page 189, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the eastern edge of the concrete of the Old Augusta Road, joint front corner of Tracts Nos. 1-A and 1-B, and running thence along the line of Tract No. 1-B, N. 54-20 W. 754 feet to an iron pin in the line of property of Donaldson Army Air Base, joint rear corner of Tracts Nos. 1-A and 1-B; thence along the line of property of Donaldson Army Air Base, N. 43-00 E. 371 feet to a concrete monument; thence continuing along the property of said Donaldson Army Air Base, S. 83-48 E. 426 feet to a concrete monument; thence continuing along the line of property of Donaldson Army Air Base, S. 8-05 W. 165.6 feet to a
