

Il that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina containing one and six hundredths (1.66) acres of land, more or less.
Adjoining lands of myself, Cooley, Haskell George and possibly others.
Having the following courses and distances, to wit:  BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint corner of Harold George and - Cooley, and running thence N. 5-15 W. 79.5 feet to an iron pin at Branch; thence along Branch S. 88 E. 65 feet to an angle; thence N. 74 E. 115 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-45 E. 27 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44 E. 172.6 feet to an iron pin at terrace; thence S. 62 E. 50 feet to an angle; thence S. 47-30 E. 50 feet to an angle; thence S. 13-30 E.
