to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Louise Trammell, her heirs and assigns forever:

All our undivided right, title and interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina in Cleveland Township and at River Falls containing 9 acres, more or less, known and designated as Tract No. 4 according to plat of property of Mrs. J. D. Trammell, made by J. C. Hill, February 24, 1961 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in road at the southeast corner of Tract No. 3 and running thence with line of Tract No. 3, S. 77 W. 592 feet to iron pin; thence S. 44 W. 220 feet to poplar; thence S. 57-30 E. 116 feet; thence S. 33-30 E. 49 feet to branch; thence with said branch as the line in a southeasterly direction 833 feet, more or less to maple and pine; thence N. 6 E. 116.8 feet to iron pin; thence N. 57-30 E. 59.4 feet; thence S. 86 E. 148.5 feet to iron pin; thence N. 15 W. 247 feet to stone; thence N. 23 E. 305 ft to a point in center of road; thence with said road in a northwesterly direction 331 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
