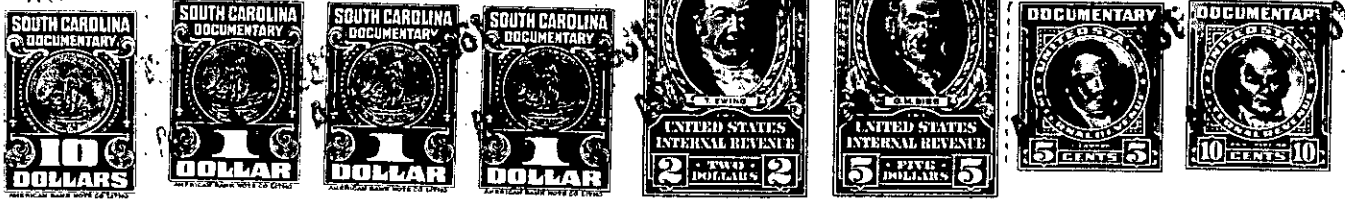

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Botany Woods, Inc.

of the sum of Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty & No/100 (\$6,250.00) - - - Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Wilbur L. Shope and Lee B. Shope, their heirs and assigns,

"All that lot of land lying on the east side of Wilmington Road, in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, shown as Lot No. 150 on plat of Botany Woods, Sector III, recorded in Plat Book RR at Page 37, and according to said plat described as follows:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Wilmington Road, at the front corner of Lot 149, and running thence with line of said lot N. 86-39 E. 180 feet to iron pin; thence N. 5-05 E. 135.5 feet to iron pin at rear corner of Lot 151; thence with line of said lot, S. 86-55 W. 200 feet to iron pin on the east side of Wilmington Road; thence with the east side of said Road S. 3-21 E. 135 feet to the beginning."

This being a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor by deed of Jas. L. Love and W. W. Wilkins, as Trustees.
