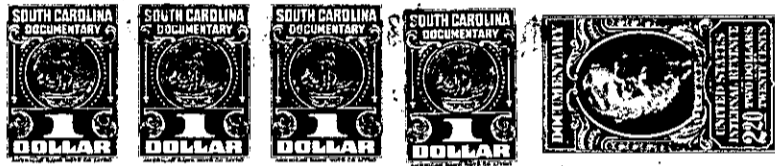
Know All Men by These Presents:

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipts whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Allen E. Vaughn, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as lot #113 of a subdivision known as Thornwood Acres, Section 2, property of Williams Land Co., which plat was prepared by J. Mac Richardson, Engineer, dated April 1959, and is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book MM, at Page 105, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Longwood Drive, the joint front corner of lots #113 and #114, and running thence along the line of these lots, N. 59-28 E. 173.5 feet to an iron pin; running thence N. 30-50 W. 80 feet to an iron pin; running thence S. 60-25 W. 165.7 feet to a concrete monument on the eastern side of Longwood Drive; thence along the eastern side of Longwood Drive which line is curved, the chord of which is S.24-57E. 66.3 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the eastern side of Longwood Drive S. 18-58 E. 13.7 feet to an iron pin, point of beginning.
