WHEREAS,

HERBERT H. BOSWORTH, 300 Tunnel Road, Asheville, North Carolina and JACK STEWART, 128 Richmond Hill Drive, Asheville, North Carolina

did on the 16th day of May, 1961, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is MACHINE ACCOUNTING SERVICE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 209 Frank Street, Greenville, South Carolina

4th. That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is (a) To engage in the business of furnishing accounting services to persons, firms and corporations through the use of business machines, equipment and forms and to provide for the public all types and forms of accounting and bookkeeping services; (b) To purchase, or otherwise acquire, own, sell, convey, hire, lease and otherwise deal in and dispose of all kinds of personal property, chattels, real notes, bonds, mortgages and other securities; (c) To conduct any other business that may be capable of being profitable in connection with the business of the corporation, or to conduct and carry on any business that is adapted directly or indirectly to add to the value of the property of the corporation and the proceeds of its principal business; (d) To purchase, use, hold and dispose of stocks, bonds and other evidence of indebtedness of corporations engaged in a similar business to this corporation, or any affiliated business, and to pay for the same in cash or in property by the issuance of its own stock, bonds, or other obligations and to exercise in respect thereto all of the rights, powers and privileges of individual owners or holders thereof, and to exercise all voting powers thereon; (e) To do and perform generally all acts and things that may be deemed necessary or expedient for the proper and successful prosecution of the objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Four Thousand (\$4,000.00) Dollars payable in cash or property of equivalent value

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Four Thousand (4,000) shares of the par value of One (\$1.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 15th day of May, 1961, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors:

Herbert H. Bosworth and Jack Stewart

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Herbert Bosworth as Vice-President, Jack Stewart as Treasurer, and Jack Stewart as Secretary, Jack Stewart

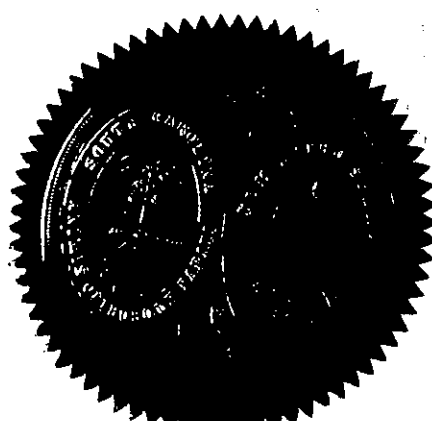
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
