KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Hugh Tallent and Marie Tallent, of Greenville County,

in consideration of (\$1.00) One and No/100----- Dollars,

love and affection, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Tillman Roger and Agnes T. Satterfield, their heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land just outside the city limits of Greenville near White Horse Road on Easley Highway in a subdivision known as Rolando Hills, according to plat made July 1950 by Piedmont Engineering Company, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book AA, at Page 71, and Lot No 2, in Block B, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Earle Drive at joint front corner of Lot Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence along the line of said lots N. 25-02 W., 140 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot No. 14; thence running with line of said lot S. 66-09 W., 70 feet to an iron pin at rear corner of Lot Nos. 2 and 1; thence running along the line of Lot Nos. 2 and 1, S. 25-02 E., 140 feet to an iron pin on Earle Drive; thence running with Earle Drive, N. 66-08 E., 70 feet to the point of BEGINNING.

This land shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to any person of African descent; no residence shall be erected on any lot costing less than \$3,000.00; nor nearer than 25 feet to the front line; nor shall any residence be erected on any lot unless said lot have 50 feet or more frontage; no outside tilets permitted and sewage to be disposed of by approved septic tanks.

THIS deed is made subject to any rights of way of record.

Well and water on the Lot. No. 3 is to be available to owners of both Lot No. 3 and NO. 2.

together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s), and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor(s)'s heirs or successors, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee(s) and the grantee(s)'s heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
