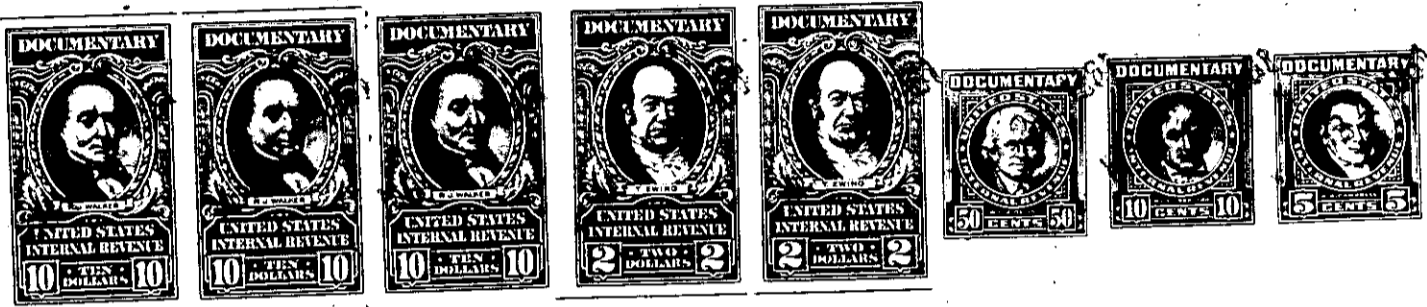

Know all Men by these Presents, That I, P. K. Rembert,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars
and other valuable consideration

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Vera D. Hughes

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Vera D. Hughes, her heirs and assigns
forever:

All those certain lots or parcels of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, near the North Carolina State Line, being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 273 and 274 on a plat of the property entitled "Lake Lanier Development, Gold Mine Section," prepared by George Kershaw, Surveyor, June, 1925, and recorded in Plat Book Volume G at page 25, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following approximate courses and distances according to said plat: Beginning at the southeastern corner of Lot No. 274 and running thence northeasterly 155 feet to a point or pin; thence northeasterly 123.6 feet to corner Lot No. 273; thence northeasterly 104 feet to corner Lot No. 265; thence as the dividing line between Lots Nos. 273 and 265, southeasterly 123 feet to a point or pin on edge of an unnamed drive or street; thence with said drive or street, curving southeasterly, 82 feet to the point of beginning. This is the same property conveyed to P. K. Rembert by deed of E. A. Burch and H. E. Duncan recorded in Deed Book 585 at page 291, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County.
