Hill, Ruth Lois McCline, James Hill, Javan Hill and Louvenia Hill, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of one dollar to each of us in hand paid, and in consideration of love and affection for our father, the grantee herein, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these Presents, by Jessie Hill, (receipt of which is now hereby auknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released and hereby do grant, bargain, selland release unto the said Jessie Hill, his heirs and assigns forever:

All of our respective right, title, interest and estate, of, in and to that piece, parcel or lot of land, with any improvements thereon, in C ity of Greer, Chick Springs Township, said County and State, and School District #285, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-

Situate on the east side of South Main Street of said City, and on the west side of the Pelham Road, now known as Pelham Street, and beginning at an iron pin on the side-walk on Pelham Street, corner of the (now or formerly) H. E. Mayfield Estate, and runs thence with the west side of of Pelham Street, S 31-50 W fifty (50) feet to a stake; thence a new line, N 60-01 W one hundred (100) feet, more or less, to a stake in the center of South Main Street; thence with the center of South Main Street, N 6-50 E fifty-five (55) feet, more or less, to iron pin on corner of H.E.Mayfield Estate; thence with the line of this Estate, S 60-01 E one hundred twenty-six (126) feet to the neginning corner.
