in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of

to me paid by Floyd A. Fields

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Floyd A. Fields, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the West side of Old Grove Road, and known and designated as the Eastern end of Lot No. 4, according to plat of property of John A. Carson made by J. Coke Smith, Surveyor, in February, 1946, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake, joint corner of Tracts Nos. 4 and 5, said plat, and running thence with the joint lines of said lots, S. 74-30 W. 450 feet; thence S. 15-30 E. 100 feet to line of Tract No. 3; thence N. 74-30 E. 450 feet to a stake on the West side of Old Grove Road; thence with said Road, N. 15-30 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by E. V. Abrams by deed dated November 13, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 466, at page 458.
