ALL that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 34 of a subdivision known as Rosedale as shown on plat thereof prepared by C. O. Riddle, R.L.S., February, 1959, revised May and June, 1960, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Pages 112 and 113, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Rosemary Lane at the point where the northern side of Rosemary Lane intersects a turnaround at the end of said street, and running thence along the northern side of Rosemary Lane, N. 73-52 W. 84.4 feet to an iron pin; thence following the curvature of Rosemary Lane as it intersects with Tulane Circle, the chord of which is N. 28-52 W. 35.4 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Tulane Circle; thence along the eastern side of Tulane Circle, N. 16-08 E. 125 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 73-52 E. 196.4 feet to an iron pin on the western edge of a 68-foot right-of-way for a Duke Power Company transmission line; thence along the western edge of said right-of-way, S. 40-31 W. 139.3 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of said turnaround; thence following the curvature of said turnaround, the chord of which is S. 68-13 W. 37.6 feet to the beginning corner.
