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BILL OF SALE AND ASSIGNMENT

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT:

WHEREAS, by Indenture of Assignment and Agreement dated **August 29, 1956**, DRAPER CORPORATION (hereinafter sometimes called Draper), a Maine corporation with its principal place of business in Hopedale, Massachusetts, subject to the terms and provisions of said Indenture of Assignment and Agreement dated **August 29, 1956** did grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over to STATE MUTUAL LIFE ASSURANCE COMPANY OF WORCESTER (hereinafter sometimes called State), a Massachusetts corporation with its principal place of business in Worcester, Massachusetts, all its right, title and interest in and to those items of machinery and equipment the subject of and designated in the schedule and/or schedules annexed to that certain Lease Agreement DL - 105 dated **June 11, 1956**, by and between Draper, as Lessor, and J. P. STEVENS & CO., INC. as Lessee, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singularly the said items of machinery and equipment to the said State, its successors and assigns, to its and their own use and behoof forever; and

WHEREAS, subject to the terms and provisions thereof Draper by said Indenture of Assignment and Agreement dated **August 29, 1956**, did grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over to State all its right, title, and interest as Lessor in, to and under said Lease Agreement DL -105 dated **June 11, 1956**, said Indenture of Assignment and Agreement dated **August 29, 1956**, being recorded under date of **Sept. 11, 1956**, with the **Town Clerk of Hopedale, Mass., in Book 5, page 84, Personal Property Mortgages** and said Lease Agreement DL -105 dated **June 11, 1956**, being recorded under date of **July 3, 1956**, in the **R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, South Carolina, in Chattle Mortgage Book 835, page 69;**

NOW THEREFORE, for value received, State does hereby grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over to Draper all its right, title and interest in and to those items of machinery and equipment the subject of and designated in the schedule and/or schedules annexed to said Lease Agreement DL -105 dated **June 11, 1956**, and all of its right, title and interest in, to and under the said Lease Agreement DL -105 dated **June 11, 1956**;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same unto the said Draper its successors and assigns forever, and State covenants and warrants to Draper that State is the lawful owner of said machinery and equipment and rights under said lease and that all of the same are free from all liens and encumbrances; that State has a good right and title to sell the same; that State will warrant and defend same against the lawful claims and demands of all persons.
