Know All Men by These Presents:

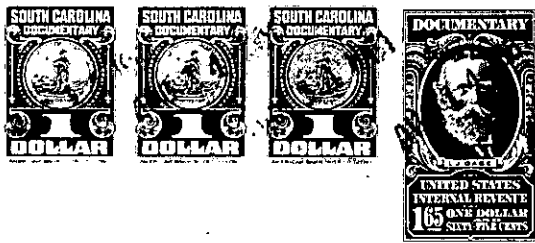
That I, J. Frank Williams

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 20 of Oak Hill, Plat of which is recorded in Plat Book MM, at Page 29, and according to said Plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southeasterly side of Oak Hill Drive, at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21, and running thence with the line of said Lots, S. 40-52 E. 150 feet; thence S. 49-08 W. 75 feet; thence N. 40-52 W. 150 feet to a point on Oak Hill Drive; thence with Oak Hill Drive, N. 49-08 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.
