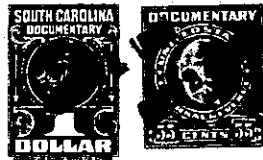

in consideration of Five Hundred Dollars and no/100----- (\$500.00)----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto James E. Knight & Charlotte E. Knight

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township being known and designated as Lot No. 28 according to a plat of the property of Lloyd Gilstrap prepared August 10, 1957 by Dean C. Edens, R. L. S. and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 00 at Pages 66 and 67 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Hope St. the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 27 & 28, and running thence with the line of Lot no. 27, S. 59-W. 282 feet to a nail cap in center of Old Farris Bridge Road; thence N. 13-30 W. 85 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 54- W. 247 feet to an iron pin; thence along the Western side of Hope St., S. 38-30 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being a portion of the same conveyed to me by Paul Hammond by his deed dated August 13, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume 506 at Page 76.
