Agreement to devise and bequeath by will, Cantrell and Sloan

me as a member of the family and care for me generally so long as I shall live. It is agreed and understood that I alone, shall be the sole judge of the proper treatment of myself and that the terms of this contract shall be considered complied with without additional proof provided that I do not give notice in writing to Reba Mae Slaon and some other responsible person prior to my death giving notice that I have not been properly treated. It is further agreed that in the event that I should give notice revoking this contract, the same Reba Mae Sloan and her husband shall have a valid claim against my estate for my care during the time they have spent with me and any and all improvements to my property provided for by them upon satisfactory proof of same, less a proper amount for their occupancy during that time.

In consideration of the agreement by Bessie D. Bridges Cantrell to devise and bequeath by will all of her remaining property at the time of her decease, I, Reba Mae Sloan, agree to live with and care for the said Bessie D. Bridges Cantrell during the remainder of her natural life, to provide the necessities of life for her, to give her the proper medical attention if needed and treat her as a member of the family. I further agreedas a part of this contract to provide a decent burdal for her upon her decease, subject to a satisfactory conclusion of this contract. I further agree that any funds received by her prior to her death from her real estate, such as rentals, etc., shall be hers to dispose of as she sees fit. It is further agreed that if the need arises to sell some part of the real estate prior to the death of Bessie D. Bridges Cantrell, it shall be permissable, provided the main dwelling and a reasonable lot therewith is not disposed of.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, Bessie D. Bridges Cantrell and Reba Mae Sloan, have hereunto set their hands and seals to this instrument this 26th day of April, in the year one thousand nine hundred and sixty one.
