All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near the City of Greenville, and known and designated as Lot #16, on the northern side of Sylvania Drive, of a subdivision known as Dogwood Terrace, as shown on a plat prepared by J. Mac Richardson, Engineer, dated May 1960, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book UU, at page 5, and according to said plat having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
