County, State of South Carolina, all that lot of land situate in the County and State aforesaid in Paris Mountain Township and having the following metes and courses:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North and running thence S. 71-21 E for 332.7 to an iron pin on the County Road, thence N 52-18 E to an iron pin for 60.2; thence S 71-21 E to an iron pin for 43.1 thence S 33-30 W for 68.4 to an iron pin near spring, thence S 5.00 E for 109.8 to an iron pin (Stake in orange) thence S 00-03 W for 467.1 to an iron pin thence N 13-10 E for 341.4 to an iron pin at the beginning point.
