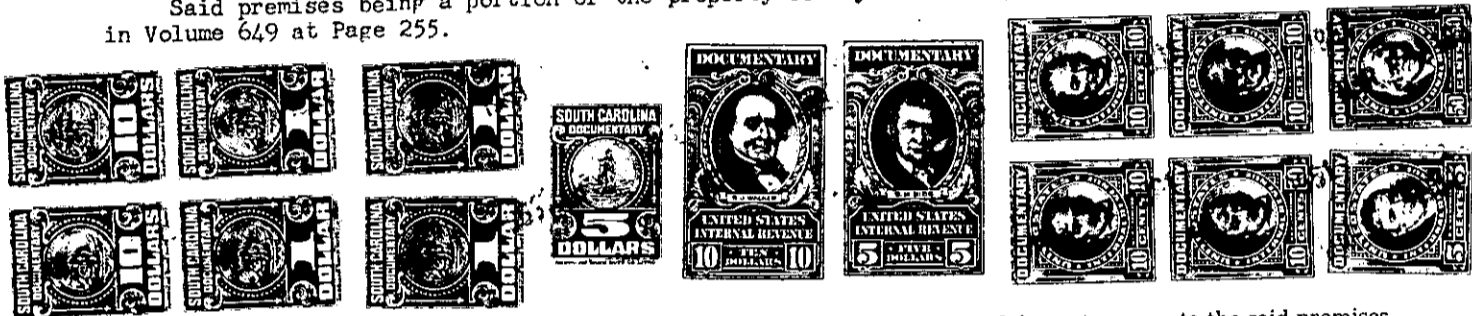

Henderson and Betty W. Henderson, their heirs and assigns,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate on the southwest corner of the intersection of Orchid Drive and Haynsworth Road, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as the major portion of Lot 14 on plat of Cedar Lane Gardens, recorded in Plat Book GG at Page 139 (now Westwood Terrace), and being more particularly described by metes and bounds, as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Orchid Drive, and running thence with the line of Lot 13, N. 40-49 W. 125 feet to pin; thence N. 62-53 E. 116.5 feet, more or less, to pin on Haynsworth Road; thence with the southwestern side of Haynsworth Road, S. 27-22 E. 83.3 feet; thence with the curve of the intersection of Haynsworth Road and Orchid Drive, S. 10-54 W. 39.3 feet to pin on Orchid Drive; thence with the northwestern side of Orchid Drive, S. 49-11 W. 67.2 feet to the point of beginning.
