

ALSO

ALL that lot; piece or parcel of land, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in Northbridge Terrace, Section 2, St. Andrews Parish, County of Charleston, State of South Carolina, and shown and designated as Lot 8, Block L, on a plat entitled "Map of Northbridge Terrace, Section 2", from a survey on March 27, 1958, by W.
