"All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and described as follows:

¹³⁸⁶ BEGINNING at stone 3x near a cabin on the road, thence S. 87-1/2 W. 21.00 to stone 3x; thence S. 35-3/4 E. 12.50⁸²⁵ to stone 3x; thence S. 76-1/2 E. 17.60^{1191.6} to stone 3x on the aforesaid road, the line to the beginning corner, bounded by M. Chapman, et al, containing 17-1/2 acres, more or less. Being same tract of land conveyed to U. S. Chapman by E. Inman, Master, by deed dated December, 1919."

ALSO: "All that certain tract of land situate in Greenville County State of South Carolina, in Dunklin Township, and being a part of the land described in deed of S. N. Chapman, N. P. Chapman, as Executors of the Will of Wm. P.
