WHEREAS, pursuant to and in compliance with Sections 12-641 and 12-642 of Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, all of the stockholders of Marsh Supermarkets of South Carolina, Inc., a South Carolina corporation, in a recent meeting unanimously voted that the corporation be liquidated and dissolved by the transfer of all of its real and personal assets to its parent corporation, Marsh Supermarkets, Inc., an Indiana corporation, in cancellation of all of the outstanding capital stock of the dissolving corporation;

NOW, THEREFORE,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

Marsh Supermarkets of South Carolina, Inc. (being named FOOD-LANE, INCORPORATED, before Charter amendments changing its name to Marsh Supermarkets of South Carolina, Inc.), a South Carolina corporation, in consideration of the premises and of the surrender and delivery to it by Marsh Supermarkets, Inc., an Indiana corporation, of all of the outstanding

to it in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by Marsh Supermarkets, Inc., an Indiana corporation, ~~xxxxxx~~
~~xxxxxx stock of said~~ (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged)

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Marsh Supermarkets, Inc., its Successors and Assigns forever:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 48 acres, bounded by lands now or formerly of H. M. Hawkins, E. W. King, J. A. Jones (now Miller) et al, and being more particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Laurens Road, at King's corner, and running thence N 80 W 5.30 chains; thence continuing along said road N 57 1/2 W 4.37 chains; thence continuing along said road N 41 1/2 W 5.39 chains; thence continuing along said road N 34-3/4 W 9.31 chains to an iron pin in center of said road, corner of E. T. Trammell and J. A. Jones; thence leaving the Laurens Road, and running thence with line of J. A. Jones N 51 1/2 E 17.25 chains to a stone; thence N 84-1/3 E 18.30 chains to a pine stump; thence S 26 1/2 W 30.60 chains along E. W. King's line to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to FOOD-LANE, INCORPORATED, from Lena A. Looper by deed dated November 17, 1958, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Book 610, at page 478.

The name of FOOD-LANE, INCORPORATED, was changed on April 4, 1960, to Marsh Supermarkets, Inc. (a South Carolina corporation), reference hereby being made to Charter Book 4, page 334, in the office of the Clerk of Court for Anderson County, South Carolina. The name of said Marsh Supermarkets, Inc. (a South Carolina corporation) was changed on November 5, 1960, to Marsh Supermarkets of South Carolina, Inc. (a South Carolina corporation), reference being made to Charter Book 4, at page 377 in said office.
