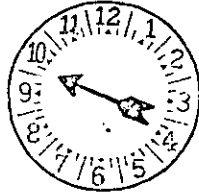

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, beginning on the south side of Caesar's Head Drive, the western corner of lot #72, (now owned by B.A. Hagood) and running thence with the original B.A. Hagood line S. 3-20 W. 185 ft. to the line of cliff, thence with line of cliff 160 ft. to a stake, thence N. 35-34 W. 125 ft. to Caesar's Head Drive, thence with Caesar's Head Drive, N. 77-06 E. 50 ft. to a bend in Drive, thence with Drive, N. 58-23 E. 50 ft. to the point of beginning, and being lot #73, Section "A" development, Caesar's Head, per survey of R.E. Dalton, October 9, 1924.
