(Louisiana No. 38—Columbia St. and Riverside Dr., Bogalusa)

HINDS COUNTY

Highway 49, said iron pin marking the point of beginning of the lands herein described; thence continue along this line a distance of 130 feet to an iron pin; thence turn left 90° and run Northwesterly 106.05 feet to the South right of way line of relocated Corley Avenue; thence run Westerly and along a 57° 37' 34" curve 20.28 feet to an iron pin which intersects with the center line curve of Corley Avenue, as originally laid out and shown on the plat of Shady Oaks Subdivision; thence turn left and run in a Southwesterly direction, along a 44° 09' 51" curve, a distance of 60.20 feet measured along said curve on 10 foot chords to an iron pin; thence continue in a Southwesterly direction 89.0 feet to an iron pin which intersects the new right of way line of U. S. Highway 49; thence turn left through an angle of 90° 15' 30" and run Southeasterly and along said new right of way line of U. S. Highway 49 a distance of 140 feet to the point of beginning, being the same land conveyed by W. T. Neely by deed dated May 5, 1959, and recorded in Book 1146, page 129, Hinds County Deed Records.
