It appears from the evidence presented and the Court so finds, that the allegations contained in the Complaint herein are true and correct and that the plaintiff is entitled to a divorce a vinculo matrimonii from the defendant upon the ground of constructive desertion, she having been compelled to leave the home by reason of the defendant's conduct which was in itself a ground for divorce; that all proceedings herein have been regular in every respect; that the Court has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this action and of the parties hereto; and that the original Complaint herein was duly filed in the office of the Clerk of Court for Sumter County, South Carolina, more than three months from date hereof.
