That We, Joe O. Charping and H. J. Martin

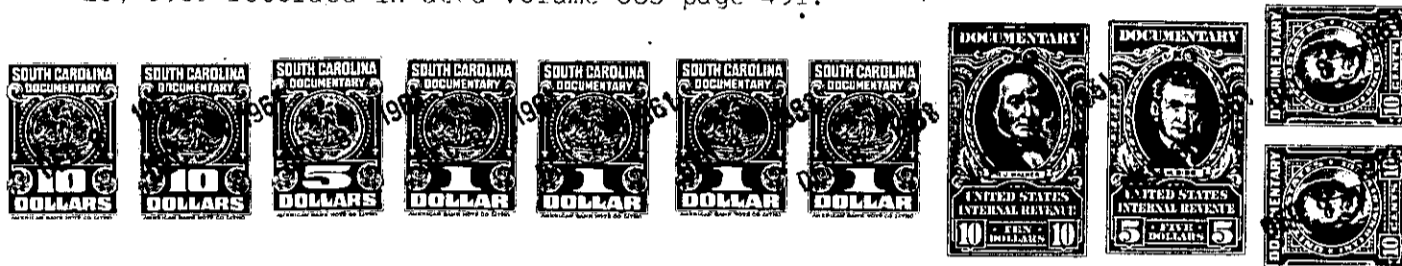
in consideration of the sum of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred (\$14,500.00) in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Edward J. Locklin and Mary P. Locklin,

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, near the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number 8 of a subdivision known as Timberlake, Section III, a plat of which is of record in the RMC Office for Greenville County in plat book EE at page 4, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the northeastern side of Sedgefield Drive at the joint front corner of lots 7 and 8 and running thence N. 44-55 E. 180 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8; thence N. 45-05 W. 100 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 8 and 9; thence S. 44-55 W. 180 feet to a point on the northeastern side of Sedgefield Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 8 and 9; thence with the northeastern side of Sedgefield Drive S. 45-05 E. 100 feet to the point of beginning.
