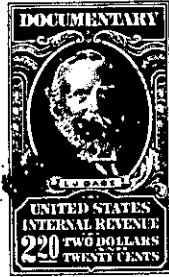

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand, Eight Hundred (\$1,800.00) - - - - - Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. A. Barnhardt, his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, and more particularly described as the remaining unused portion of Lot No. 179, Section "C", of Springwood Cemetery located in the City of Greenville, and originally having the following dimensions, to-wit:

16 feet by 24 feet, approximately.

Such conveyance is made for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also subject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council and Cemetery Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to said Cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

And the Grantee herein is further restricted from removing or changing any monuments or markers in memory of Harold Alexander, Innis Alexander, Willie Alexander, Ruby Alexander and Eva Alexander, heretofore buried in Lot No. 179, Section "C" of Springwood Cemetery.

The used portion of said lot constituting the northeast corner of said lot with dimensions of 7 ft. x 8 ft. approximately.
