the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE GRANTED, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said J.S. Gleason, Jr., as Administrator of Veterans Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot #4, Echols Drive, on plat of property of Elizabeth E. Voyles, recorded in Plat Book Y at Page 73, in the R. M.C. Office for Greenville County, and being more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the northern side of Echols Drive, said iron pin being 386.8 feet east of the intersection of Echols Drive and Augusta Road, at the joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4, and running thence with the line of Lot 3, N. 21-42 W. 115 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 68-18 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence with the line of Lot 5, S. 21-42 E. 115 feet to an iron pin on Echols Drive; thence with Echols Drive, S. 68-18 W. 100 feet to the beginning corner."
