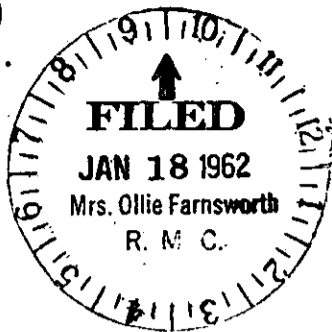

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Julian Calhoun

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Julian Calhoun, his heirs and assigns forever, all of our right, title and interest in lots numbered 80 and 1051 as recorded on the plats of the Lake Lanier property in district #436. It has been found that these two lots were excluded from deed made to Julian Calhoun by the said Commission, said deed dated Feby 15th. 1959 and recorded in Book 617 at page #359. It is noted in the record of George F. Miller, Tax Collector that lot #80 shows to have been withdrawn from sale and lot #1051 had previously been deeded to Julian Calhoun by deed recorded 571 at 403, and found to have been in error, and this error corrected by deed to Julian Calhoun dated Dec. 20th. 1961 and recorded, same recorded 689 at 157. By reference to Book 623 at page 502 it can be seen that Lanier Realty compnay had conveyed both of these lots to said Julian Calhoun, indicating in deed that they had been sold for taxes, and while the deed from the Commission indicates that they had been sold to other
