BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

did on the 29th day of January, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is THE GENERAL FIREPROOFING COMPANY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 409 East North Street, Greenville, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

Said corporation is formed for the purpose of manufacturing, fabricating, constructing, assembling, finishing, installing, buying, selling, leasing, distributing and otherwise producing and dealing in all types and forms of furniture, furnishings, fixtures, equipment, materials, supplies, appliances, accessories and products of every kind and description, whether made of metal or of any other substance, including, but not limited to, desks, chairs, tables, transfer cases, vertical uprights, horizontal units, storage and filing cabinets, safes, shelving, counters, custom-built and specially designed work, and any and all other products and articles the manufacture of which may in anywise be deemed advisable in connection with the manufacturing business of the corporation; owning, constructing, purchasing, leasing or otherwise acquiring, operating, maintaining, selling, dealing in or otherwise disposing of manufacturing plants, factories, warehouses, office buildings, branch offices, real, personal and intangible property, inventions, letters patent, trade marks, trade names, copyrights, licenses and all other facilities and agencies necessary, convenient or useful in the manufacture, production, distribution and sale of any of such articles or incidental in carrying on the business and effecting the objects and purposes of the corporation; lending money to any individual, firm, association or corporation and acquiring all or any part of the good will, property and business of any corporation, association, partnership, syndicate, other entity, or individual, heretofore or hereafter engaged in any business similar to the business of the corporation, or otherwise, and to pay for the same in cash or in shares or obligations of the corporation or otherwise, and to assume in connection therewith any liabilities thereof, and to conduct in the State of South Carolina and/or in any other state, ^{where permitted} locality of country the whole or any part of the business thus acquired, provided such business is not prohibited by the laws of the State of South Carolina; and for the purpose of doing all other things necessary, incident or connected with the prosecution of the foregoing business or any part thereof.
