 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ida Jo Hartsell Curry,
 her heirs and assigns,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville
 County, State of South Carolina, In the City of Greenville, having the follow-
 ing metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on St. John Street (now Ansel Street) 132.8
 feet from intersection of Green Avenue and St John Street (now Ansel
 Street) thence S. 11 W. 239.8 feet along line of Lot # 2 to iron pin
 on a 12 foot alley in rear; thence with said alley N. 79 W. 56 feet
 to an iron pin; thence N. 11 E. 239.8 feet to an iron pin on St. John
 Street (now Ansel Street); thence with St. John Street (now Ansel
 Street) 79 E. 56 feet to the beginning corner. Being a part of Lot
 No. 3, Plat recorded in Plat Book H.H. 351; D D D, 903. Being the
 same property conveyed to our father, Herbert L. Curry, Sr., by Maggie
 E. Ross, deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in
