

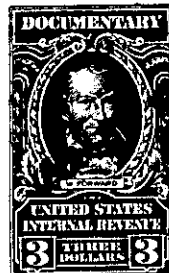

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I, Lillian L. Owen of the County of Greenville,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Exchange of property valued at Six Thousand (\$6,000.00) Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Lloyd W. Gilstrap,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Lloyd W. Gilstrap, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the eastern side of Maco Terrace, known as Lot No. 4 of property of Central Realty Corporation, according to a plat of said property made by Pickell & Pickell, dated March 13, 1946, recorded in Plat Book P, Page 7, R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at a point on the east side of Maco Terrace, joint corner of lots numbers 3 and 4, which said corner is 230 feet from the center of Maco Terrace and Ackley Road, and running thence with Maco Terrace, S. 36-05 E. 60 feet to a point, joint corner of lots numbers 4 and 5; thence with the joint line of lots 4 & 5, N. 54-03 E. 125 feet to a point, joint rear corner of said lots numbers 4 & 5 thence N. 36-05 W. 60 feet to a point, joint rear corner of lots numbers 3 and 4 thence with the joint line of lots numbers 3 and 4 S. 54-03 W. 125 feet to the beginning corner, corner of lots numbers 3 and 4 on the east side of Maco Terrace.
