C., and the Commissioners of Public Works of Greenville, S. C., the undersigned Belton Light and Power Company, a South Carolina corporation, the owner of certain lands bordering on both sides of the said Saluda River on which it operates a hydroelectric plant, does hereby bargain, grant, sell and convey unto the said City of Greenville, and the Commissioners of Public Works of Greenville, S. C., their successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement of taking from the North Saluda River and its tributaries at the location of its dam and appurtenant facilities recently completed in the Northern portion of Greenville County generally referred to as the North Saluda River Watershed Project of the Greenville City Water Works, such amounts of the water of the said streams as the said city and its Commissioners of Public Works may now or hereafter require for the use of the said city and surrounding territory now or hereafter served by the said City or its Commissioners of Public Works, including the right to impound from time to time such waters of said River and its tributaries as may be impounded by the Dam constituting a part of the said project as it now stands.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said right, privileges and easements unto the said City of Greenville, and the Commissioners of Public Works of Greenville, S. C., their successors and assigns, forever.
