THIS INDENTURE made the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1962, between  
JESSE M. RAY, as Special Master, party of the first part, and  
FEDERAL NATIONAL MORTGAGE ASSOCIATION, a corporation organized and

WHEREAS, the United States District Court in and for the  
Western District of South Carolina, Greenville Division, by its de-  
cree dated January 19, 1962, among other things, ordered, adjudged and  
decreed in a certain cause then pending in the said Court between  
Federal National Mortgage Association, complainant, and William Oscar  
Knight, Jack W. Gilstrap, Jr., and Mary B. Gilstrap, being Case No.  
3077 Civil; that the mortgaged premises, in which defendant's wife,
