All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Northeast side of Nicholtown Road and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of Nicholtown No. 4 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "N", at Page 139 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
