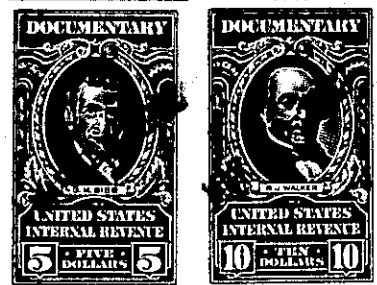
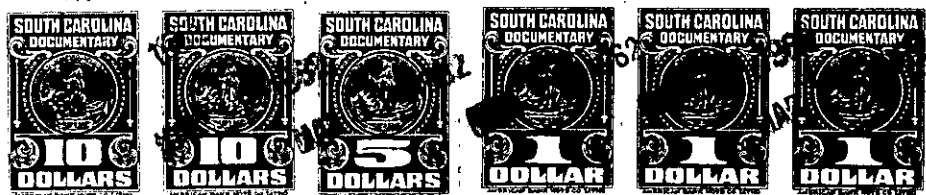

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being on Folkstone Street, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 101 on plat of Chestnut Hills No. 1, which plat is recorded in the R.
