WHEREAS, Garrison Plumley

on or about the 20th day of December in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and Sixty One exhibited his
complaint in the County Court for the County aforesaid, against
Mary Pruitt Plumley, et al

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard
on the 23rd day of April 1962,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and
decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN, Master in and for
the County aforesaid, to Shelton J. Rimer

for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County of
Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, upon receipt of \$3,000.00

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Shelton J. Rimer

ALL that certain, parcel or tract of land in Glassy Mt. Township, said
County and State, on Brushy Creek Ford, branch waters of South Pacolet
River, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a Chestnut Tree 3 x and running a south course to a rock
3 X a new corner on the line of Jacob Ballou and Jeff Howard, and running
northeast by a cliff to a hickory 3 X, thence north to a pine 3 X to the
old line; thence with said line to the beginning corner, containing three
acres more or less.

ALSO, all that other parcel of land in the aforesaid Township, County and
State, on headwaters of South Pacolet River, Bounded by lands of Rachel
Lindsey, Jeff Howard, James Gosnell, P. D. Gilreath, and others, and
known as part of the Jacob Ballou lands, containing ninety acres, more or
less.

ALSO, that other parcel of land situate in the said Township, County and
State, known as a portion of the lands of E. J. Howard conveyed by Nancy
Harrison, and lying on Sycamore, Waters of Green Creek, beginning on a
rock corner of Margaret Ballou and running thence a small distance south,
below the Mountain Hill Road to an oak stump, Mrs. Margaret Ballou's corner
near the road, running thence southeast with the line that was established
by J. D. Davis, Surveyor, agreed on by James Lindsey, Jr. and James
Ballou to a Black Gum 3 X, E. J. Howard's corner, running thence north-
east to a Spanish Oak 3 X on Margaret Ballou's line; thence North a
plantation road to a rock 3 X, running thence with said road to a maple
