to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Betty Jane Sudduth and her heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located about 1 1/2 miles east of Blue Ridge High School, being shown on a plat prepared for the Fred H. Sudduth Estate by Terry T. Dill, surveyor, to be hereafter recorded, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a point in the center of the Old Greenville Road (iron pin on east bank thereof on line), corner with Nettie S. Starnes' tract, and runs thence with her line, S. 49-20 E. 1105 feet to an iron pin and S. 8-30 E. 461.2 feet to an iron pin on James Stewart's line; thence with Stewart's line, as follows: S. 89-31 W. 875 feet to an iron pin and stone, N. 5-15 W. 204.5 feet to an iron pin, N. 8 W. 225.5 feet to an iron pin, N. 24-45 W. 103.5 feet to an iron pin, N. 29-50 W. 272 feet to an iron pin, and N. 26-30 W. 182 feet to a point in the center of the Old Greenville Road (iron pin on east bank thereof on line); thence N. 47-26 E. 384 feet to the beginning, containing 19 acres, more or less.
