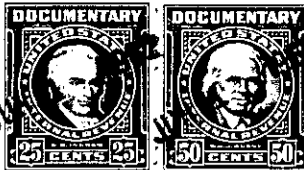
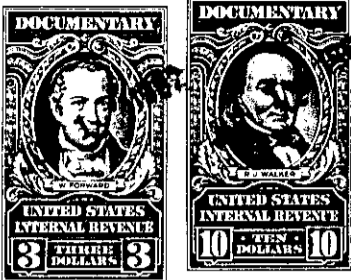

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That I,

B. C. Scott,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of TWELVE THOUSAND, FIVE HUNDRED (\$12,500.00) and no/100 Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Roland McKittrick Knight

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Roland McKittrick Knight, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville, on the south side of Dunbar Street, with the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the west corner of lot now or formerly owned by Minnie G. Willimon on Dunbar Street and running thence along the South side of Dunbar Street N. 76 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 8 shown on plat hereinafter referred to; thence S. 18 W. 215 feet to iron pin touching A. C. Davis line; thence S. 76 E. 50 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot conveyed by W. H. Irvine to Minnie G. Willimon; thence N. 18 E. with Willimon line of said lot 215 feet to the beginning corner, and known as lot No. 9 on Plat made by W. A. Hudson, November 29, 1901, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book "A" at page 163.
