

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

We, the undersigned, John Earle, Asheville, North Carolina; Hugh W. Whitworth, Lavonia, Georgia; L. Reeder Tucker, Royston, Georgia; James G. Simpson, Asheville, North Carolina; Norman Sanders, Columbia, South Carolina; and Stan B. Marshall, Belton, South Carolina, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a cooperative association, with capital stock, under the provisions of the Cooperative Marketing Act of the State of South Carolina, being Sections 12-901 to 12-975, both inclusive, of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the association shall be Marshall Farms Cooperative.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES

The association is formed for the following purposes:
To engage in any activity in connection with: the producing, marketing, selling, processing, packing, storing, handling or utilization of poultry products produced by its members and other farmers; the manufacturing, processing or marketing of the byproducts thereof; the performing or furnishing of farm business services for producers of such pro-
