

Section 2. LIMITATIONS. This association, during any fiscal year thereof, shall not deal in or handle products, equipment, machinery or supplies or perform services for and on behalf of non-members in an amount greater in value than such as are dealt in, handled or performed by it for and on behalf of members during the same period. Business done for and on behalf of the United States or any of its agencies shall be disregarded in determining the limitations imposed by this section.

ARTICLE IV

PLACE OF BUSINESS

The association shall have its principal place of business at Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina.

ARTICLE V

PERIOD OF EXISTENCE

The term for which this association shall exist is 50 years from and after the date of its incorporation.

ARTICLE VI

DIRECTORS

The number of directors of the association shall be not less than six. The names and addresses of those who are to serve as incorporating directors until the first annual meeting of the members or until their successors are elected and qualified are:
