CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, Otis S. Boan, Route #1, Cheraw, South Carolina
William Franklin Sawyer, 801 Ridgedale Drive, Spartanburg, S. C.
Dorothy R. Sawyer, 801 Ridgedale Drive, Spartanburg, S. C.

did on the 9th day of July, 19 62, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

- FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.
- SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is WORLD FINANCE CORPORATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA
- THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to lend money and negotiate loans and generally to carry on, conduct, promote, operate, and undertake any business, transaction, or operation commonly carried on, conducted, promoted, operated, or undertaken by capitalists, financiers, contractors and builders, insurance brokers and agents, loan brokers and agents, real estate agents, brokers, dealers, subdividers, and promoters, and securities brokers and agents.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00)----- Dollars payable in cash, accounts receivable and services

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Five Thousand (5,000) shares of the par value of One (\$1.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 5th day of July, 19 62, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Otis S. Baon, William Franklin Sawyer, Dorothy R. Sawyer

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Otis S. Boan ; as Vice-President, William Franklin Sawyer ; as Secretary, Dorothy R. Sawyer ; as Treasurer, Dorothy R. Sawyer

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
