CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

Boyce Robbins, 11 W. Tallulah Drive, Greenville, S. C.  
 Jack Garrison Robbins, 14 Hawthorne Lane, Greenville, S. C.  
 William Leslie Robbins, Butler Springs Road, Greenville, S. C.  
 Wilbur Robbins, Old Georgia Road, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 14th day of August, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **ROBBINS BROS., INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **3511 Augusta Road, Greenville, S. C.**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is **water well drilling, drilling for oil and gas and exploratory drilling; manufacture, repair and install well pumps and water systems; to acquire, own, improve and sell real estate.**

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00)**-----Dollars payable **in goods, cash or both**

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **Two Hundred (200)** of the par value of **Fifty (\$50.00) per share**----- Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **13th** day of **August**, 1962, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **Boyce Robbins, Jack Garrison Robbins, William Leslie Robbins, Wilbur Robbins**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **Boyce Robbins** ;  
 as Vice-President, **Jack Garrison Robbins** ; as Secretary, **William Leslie Robbins** ;  
 as Treasurer, **Wilbur Robbins**

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by *bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **The Greenville Piedmont**

a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
