CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

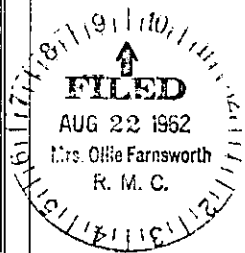
did on the 14th day of August, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is DOMESTIC LOANS OF GREENVILLE, N. C.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 1007 Barringer Building, Columbia, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to engage in a general loan and investment business; to buy, sell, deal and invest in real estate and personal property, including notes, mortgages, stocks, bonds and other securities; to engage in such other types or kinds of business as the directors of the corporation may from time to time deem advisable; and to do all things necessary or incidental to the aforementioned purposes.

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FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) -----Dollars payable in cash

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Ten Thousand (10,000) of the par value of One (\$1.00) -----Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 13th day of August, 1962, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Forest H. Church, Mamie G. Bateman, W. Griswold Smith

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Forest H. Church ; as Vice-President, W. Griswold Smith ; as Secretary, Mamie G. Bateman ; as Treasurer, Mamie G. Bateman Asst. Secretary, Braxton Schell

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The State a newspaper published in the County of Richland

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
